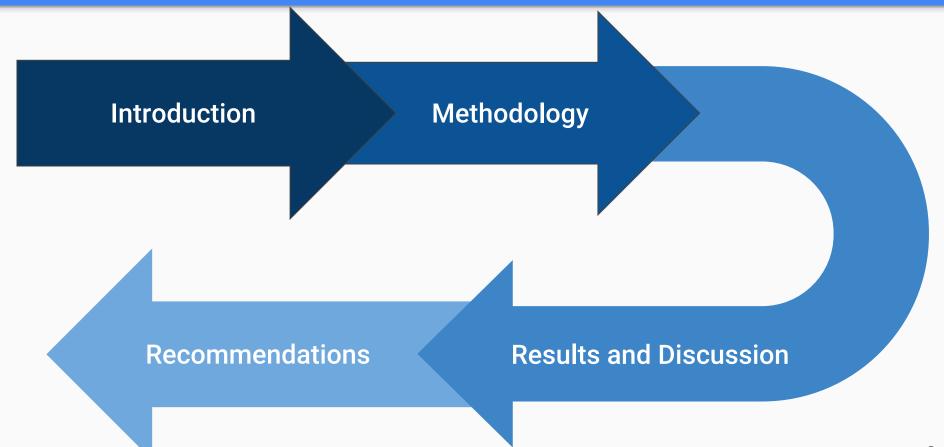

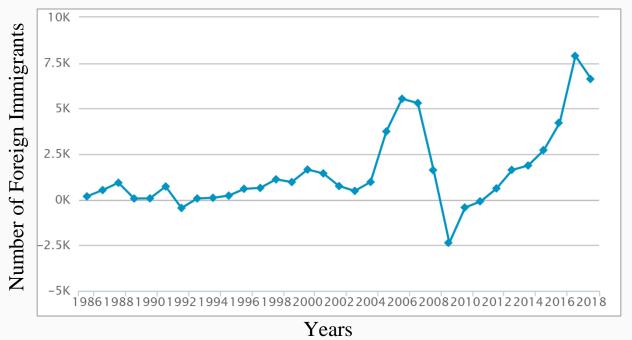


Road Map

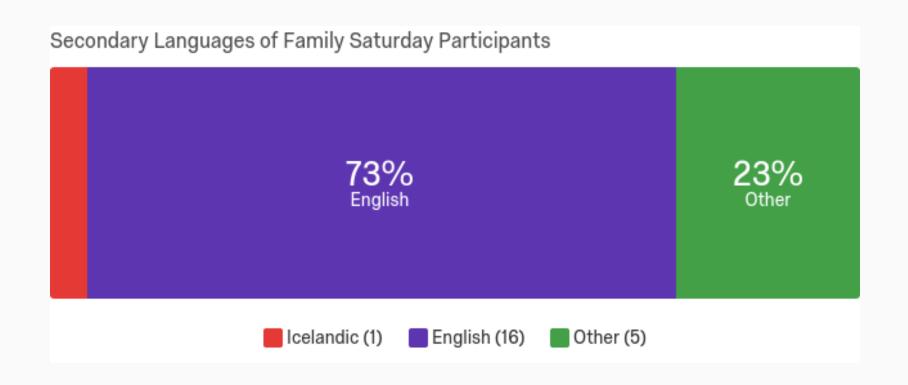

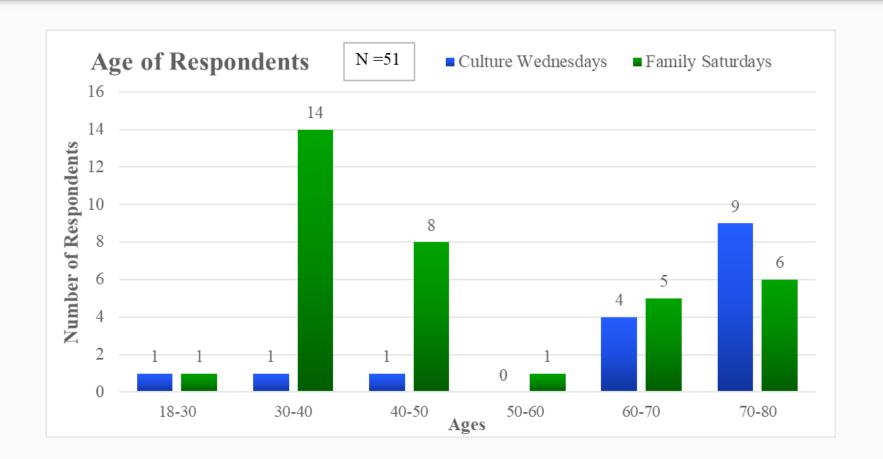

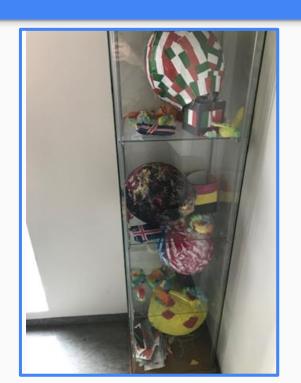
