
Problem: WPI first-years struggle to find and navigate WPI provided resources.

Solution: Deliver brief info sessions to show how to find and navigate WPI provided resources.


Info Session Focus: How to find and navigate WPI provided resources relating to classes and extracurriculars.

Collecting Data: Surveys before and after the info sessions which measure WPI student capability in finding and navigating resources. The majority of responses come from freshman.

Future Work: Spread the word about and implement recurrent info sessions.

Conclusions: Students were unaware of and struggled with finding and navigating resources prior to our info session.

The post-info session surveys showed that the info sessions reduced these difficulties.
