

Student Achievement Has been Dropping for Decades But Simply Increasing Funding has not worked




Australia's teachers Are Struggling

- Victoria faces a shortage of 5,500 secondary teachers by 2028
- Shortage driven by lacking teacher training pipelines and teachers leaving early due to disillusionment
- 13% of teachers under 50 plan to leave in the next 5 years.







Their mission is to support teachers and kids in underprivileged schools

Focus on literacy and creative writing

Made up of creatives, not teachers


Story Hubs



Early Teacher Interviews

- Even more similar websites
- More on sharing resources
- Visualizing examples for direct feedback

Common Themes

Lack of Time

Simple Resources

Discovery

Lack of Time

Fast, simple search

Short activity recaps

Easy initial experience/login

Quick access to old resources

Variety of Resources

Multiple formats of activities

Different formats of downloadable resources

Upload experience uses resources teachers use

Discovery

Find activities that match the teachers needs

Find new activities which would normally be unseen

Ability to discover and view resources using different means

User Journeys

What Are <u>User Journeys?</u>

Overarching Issues

Issues that are persistent and should always be considered



Needs

Larger needs that would significantly impact the experience



Smaller Wants

Specific issues that are easy to understand and require less complex solutions



Possible Solutions

Specific things that could be implemented to solve wants

Example User Journey

As a teacher I am very time limited

I need to easily

I want to easily find the last resource I accessed

Implement a history tab to the dashboard

I want to keep track of desired resources

Implement a favorite or save option

What We Know

What Have We Learned

Story Hubs is More Connected to Teachers

- What benefits students can often be applied to teachers as well
- Personal connections encourage teachers to fully engage with material

Teachers Lack Creative Confidence

- Struggle to consider themselves creative
- Connection with 100 Story helped improve this

They Trust Their Own Judgement

- Know what their students need
- Research and recommendations can make them look at the site
- Only personal interaction with material makes them excited users



Implement a tagging system to explore available materials

Directs users to only relevant material

Saves time

Creates a clear path teachers can follow

More convenient user experience

Create visual identifiers to communicate information quickly

Forms a consistent visual identity amongst similar materials

- convenient viewing experience
- saves time by communicating information at a glance

Create a dashboard for logged in users



Central location to store favorite activities

Saves time

Place to edit class information

Tracks class size and age group to better represent impact

Make a dedicated impact page to demonstrate real-world benefits

Shows who has been impacted by Story Hubs Digital

- Builds credibility with teachers
- Creates a source of data for grant applications

Spotlight popular activities directly on the landing page



Easily access popular materials

- Convenient for last minute users
- Allows potential new users to view the type of material produced by 100SB
 - Builds credibility to those unfamiliar
