The children have considered the way their body reacts to exercise of varying intensity walking, running, scooting and skipping. What are the benefits of these over travelling in a car? The children produce posters about this. Year 3 and Year 5 cover Healthy Living in science and investigate the benefits of active travel. The Year 6 children investigate whether it is feasible to travel to their secondary schools using active travel. To teach about the health benefits of active travel when in PE classes.Link other initiatives that if you have to drive - you use a map we produce to park away from the school and walk a short distance to the school gates.
