Interview type:

- Key-informant interview
- Semi-structured with open-ended questions
- We will start with more general questions and then probe further for more specific information
- This will allow us to understand the scope of the project and collect the necessary relevant information

Introduction:

- Hello, it's great to finally speak with you in person! We would first like to introduce ourselves.
- Introduce selves: Our name, related experience, why we chose the project or what we are looking forward to (something to allow the sponsor to get to know you as people)
- Sahana Venkatesh: Hello, my name is Sahana and I am a junior physics major pursuing my Bachelor of Science here at WPI. I'm also pursuing a minor in Data Science and a potential double major in Professional Writing. On campus, I am an undergraduate mathematical peer learning assistant and serve on the executive board for a cultural club here on campus. I chose

this project because I am interested in the university's desire to be more sustainable and how we can analyze data that can help with that endeavor.

- Sofia Merto: Hello, I'm Sofia, and I use she/her and they/them pronouns. I am a junior math major at WPI. I have always been interested in sustainability, and I am hoping this project will help others to be interested in sustainability and helping the planet as well.
- Luke Savoie: Hello, I am Luke Savoie, I am currently a junior at WPI studying Data Science. I am very excited for this project opportunity as I have an interest in sustainability, but I would definitely like to learn more. In addition, I have created 2 apps for other classes here at WPI and I was interested in the opportunity to improve the Actionbound app.
- Khaled Jarad: Hello! I am Khaled, a junior at Worcester Polytechnic Institute passionately pursuing a Bachelors in Biomedical Engineering and Professional Writing on a Pre-Law track. Outside the classroom, he serves on the executive Board of our Tour Guide program at WPI and works closely with admissions to represent WPI to prospective students.
- Thank you for taking the time to meet with us. We have been researching the Freie Universität Berlin program and are eager to learn more about what we will be working on. We have started research on the actionbound app and the Times Higher Education rankings, as well as what Universities can do to make themselves more sustainable. - And then when you learn more about aspects of the project, you can gently ask, in the seven weeks we're in Berlin, what aspect of the project from their perspective should be the focus of the project.
- You may want to inquire further about objectives, methods, or deliverables specified in the project brief, sources of information that may be available to you, or other recommendations from the sponsor about how you will either gather data, make contacts, or build relationships. You can also ask what kind of outputs the sponsor would like.
- Write out your conclusion (Thank you for your time...We will continue researching... We will reach out once we have made significant progress on our proposal...Feel free to communicate any questions or concerns through our email alias: [gr-FU-Berlin-D22])

- Bettina is recording the meeting she will share it with us, but she doesn't really want to rewatch it
- Bettina's job was originally working for research projects in the building sector, so it is unusual that she works in sustainability because sustainability is a campus unit not a research unit
 - Before that she was in charge of sustainability communication
 - A lot of the tasks of sustainability communication are still her job
 - She is in charge of sustainability reporting, the website, and the bench marks
- Any larger sustainability efforts? Is the department working on anything big?
 - Big ish unit so a lot of things are going on
 - Unusual for germany because normally they only have one or two people but fu has people in sustainability in teaching, sustainability in international networks
 - Everybody is working on something
 - There are many efforts, you can go on the website and see all the things they do, which is a lot
- The problem with the ir is not to do the ranking and collect the data (takes time, 3-5 days but) but the problem is that they have to present an sdg report every year and show the progress they made from last year
 - That will take 6-8 weeks
 - Hoping we can help
 - They made sdg contest on the website but they only got one contest on the website instead of 3
- How to go ahead with this ranking since they have this major report to do every year
 - How to report easily without consuming so many weeks
- Accidentally zoned out for a couple minutes but that's what the recording is for
- She can share with us the data that they submitted, she can show us here and she can send it to us
 - We want it sent to us please
 - This is not a stats project though
 - Make sure to email her after this thanking her for her time and ask for this spreadsheet
- Policy for child work they don't have a policy they have a law
 - Communication issue? So many of the top universities are also in countries that also have laws, maybe this data could be submitted better

SDG report for the impact ranking

In their university there is not one person in charge of sustainability

There are several offices for things like environmental, societal

They have to show that they can improve year after year which involves having objectives and indicators, but for some aspects of sustainability they do not have well defined objectives and indicators; they use this as a good next step but it's hard to get started like that

They wrote their report in french and had it translated into english

They are just finishing the french version and they are having it translated in english, they aren't sure yet if things got lost in translation

They think they are quite good at 17 (and 3 and 5)

They want to improve on 7,11,13

They did not submit data for all of the sdgs because that is a lot of work, they did the first year but after that they just submitted the data where they thought they could get the best scores

- His current responsibility lies with trying to embed climate stuff withing curriculum and student experience
- Works with a team
- Also he has responsibility for reporting
- Covers all sorts of issues
- Includes stuff like the impact ranking

How involved are you in the creation of the public SDG reports that are submitted to the impact ranking?

- Responsibility for coordinating that
- There is a vacuum going on
- We shall listen to the recording because all this is helpful but
- They don't publish what they give to the impact rankings they just publish the general report

What are the next largest projects that the sustainability department is working on?

- They work with everyone, in corporational aspects, in teaching,
- They are reviewing their climate strategy which was published in 2016 and they've already met some targets
- They don't want to go the external carbon offset route they will always be producing greenhouse gasses
- Instead they are looking to woodland preservation in scotland
- They have just created a unit for social impact
- It's quite hard to tell the wider social impact

What do you believe makes a quality SDG report?

- He is gonna break it down as what is good for the impact rankings and what is good for the stakeholders
- The impact rankings are looking for certain information to match their criteria
- Straight to the point and accessible with what you need
- He has some issues with the methodology and criteria (gamification)
- It provides a good snapshot but that's it

What he does witht the annual report is make it accessible to wider public

Language has to ve accessible

Data that they provide must be explained

What is the overall goals and outcomes of these projects

Hardly anybody is gonna look at a long detailed report and only select people care about numbers

Putting it on the website makes it more accessible to more people

Tehre needs to be a communications plan for the report

They put out an article alongside the report that highlighted top ten achievements and used that as social media posts

Tailored their messaging to different types of people within and withoutthe university

Tehre is no point producing a really complex detailed report if you're not gonna put the effort in to outreach

They have a stand alone annual report from which you can find other reports

Gamification of the report

Any external scrutiny is to be welcomed so he does welcome the impact rankings

In terms of the methodology around the scoring, your uni could submit the bare minimum and actually score really well

A lot of universities are submitting more than the bare minimum

This methodology fails to recognize the wider scope and how the sdgs are interconnected (so don't do project based pdf)

There is bias against larger universities like uni of edinburg

More specialized small universities have smaller sudtend population so there are more students going into specialised fields

It is hard to really explain to them that they do a hell of a lot

He does not think they've really earned their place at th top of the ranking

Tehre are some areas taht work well and some don't work well

Reporting is about improving current practice internally

They've identified some criteria that will help them improve

They are hoping that going forward teh IR will improve their methodology

What aspect of their report helped them to rank so high?

- Real insight to times higher education how they evaluate the data, he doesn't thik they're looking at the report
- You get more points if you got more information
- They have a process behind the stand alone report and they can use the process to gather the data that the impact rankings are looking for
- The process behind the stand alone report helps to extract info for social media
- He really likes the importance of social outreach
- Uni performance fluctuates over time sometimes you just have a good year and the methodology doesn't ask for any narrative whatsoever
- It's just a matrix and they don't care

Is tehre any aspect that really affected the ranking

- In terms of their stand alone report, they haven't made any substantial changes
- The changes are just due to changes in stakeholders
- Some universities have larger staff teams impacting the rankings
- They do provide narrative though it is not required.

What are some difficulties you've encountered while creating an SDG report?

- They are a very large university very very large
- It is hard to cover all the ground
- The annual report is only a snapshot of the activity
- There's definitely gaps in some of their data sets
 - o For instance environmetnal thehy have carbon but no social impact
- Some of their hr data is patchy and localized
- Sometimes reporting is an additional admin exercise but he values its importance
- There is a bit of a cultural barrier or assumption about reporting
- Some people don't spend enough time on reporting

Is there anything you would would recommend us as advice?

- He deosn't do reporting for reportings sake
- It is really important to reflect the important material issues
- Any report that you produce has to be of importance to organization and key stakeholders as well
- Specifically on the impact rankings, for him, it's about making sure colleagues understand what the IR are and methodology
- When you are producing the report foir the impact rankins it takes a whole orginizational approach, it's not just about one aspect

If we are looking for forums to share research there is a network that meets on a regular basis and matt is more than happy to include us in a future meeting agenda







Sponsor Description

Freie Universität Berlin is a leading research institution located in Berlin, Germany. As a public research institution, FU Berlin is one of the 13 German universities funded through the German government's Excellence Strategy (Guiding Principles, n.d). Along with its partners, Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, Technische Universität Berlin, and Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin, FU Berlin is working towards turning Berlin into an integrated research environment and one of Europe's leading research hubs (Guiding Principles, n.d).

Freie Universität Berlin was founded in 1948 by a group of professors and students. The idea of founding a free university gained a lot of support in the international community and this included financial support (Guiding Principles, n.d). This support allowed for the Universität to become a university with an outstanding internal reputation. Since 1948, the motto of the Universität has always been the three values: Truth, Justice, Liberty (Guiding Principles, n.d).

The Latin words *veritas*, *justitia*, and *libertas*, frame the seal of Freie Universität Berlin and showcase the values that define the academic ethos of the university ever since its founding (Veritas, n.d). *Veritas*, or truth, is the highest aim of the research and other teaching activities at the university. Focusing on truth allows for a clear interest in any findings and helps to protect these activities from bad academic practices (Veritas, n.d). *Justitia*, or justice, talks about the university's alignment to a canon of values that are primarily led by personal commitment and social responsibility. This pillar also shows the university's acceptance for students from all over the world (Veritas, n.d). The last word, *Libertas* or freedom, is the basic prerequisite for research and teaching activities here at FU Berlin. The interaction between the three guiding principles of the university is extremely fundamental and allows for a space of intellectual commonality and open discourse (Veritas, n.d).

In the 1960s, Freie Universität Berlin was one of the main sites in Germany for student protests aimed towards greater openness, equality, and democracy (Guiding Principles, n.d). After the German reunification in 1990, the university shifted its focus and in turn, increased its research activities, number of graduates, successful doctoral candidates, and publications (Guiding Principles, n.d).

As of the academic year 2020-2021, there are 30,000 students enrolled in bachelor's and master's degree programs at the university. Out of these students, 13% and 28% of students are from abroad in the bachelor's programs and master's programs respectively (Facts and Figures, n.d). In addition, there are 4,000 doctoral students out of which 36% are from abroad. At the university, there are also 376 professors, 93 fixed-term professors, and 4,550 staff members (Facts and Figures, n.d).

Being a leading research institution, Freie Universität Berlin has 11 academic departments, 1 joint medical school with Humboldt-Universität, 4 transdisciplinary central institutes consisting of 178 degree programs out of which 73 are undergraduate degree programs and 105 are master's degree programs. There are also a noted 51 doctoral programs (Facts and Figures, n.d).

The project aims to focus on providing FU Berlin with an overview and recommendations of the best practice in SDG which is the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals. FU Berlin is dedicated to fulfilling local and global sustainable development. From their university website, it is evident that sustainability is important in their practice as they state "Sustainability is a prominent aspect of learning and teaching at our university as well as life on campus in general." (Mission Statement, n.d). In addition, the university is open to different disciplines, methods and perspectives. Popular issues like climate change and other social and ecological transformations are also addressed in courses (Mission Statement, n.d).

Important international community issues like climate protection, conserving biodiversity, the fight against poverty, and intergenerational justice are just a few challenges that university sees the need to be met (Sustainability, n.d). In 2016, FU Berlin adopted a sustainability mission statement which pledges to implement sustainability practices in all areas of the university namely research, teaching, knowledge transfer, administration, and on campus as (Sustainability, n.d). The university also aims for the integration of education for sustainable development where sustainability is included in the university curriculum itself (Sustainability Mission, n.d).


Freie Universität Berlin is also actively involved in the discussion about the Global Sustainable Development Goals adopted by the United Nations in 2015 (Sustainability, n.d). Through research, teaching, and coursework, university members look for solutions to the previously mentioned global challenges. In 2017, 30% of the university's research projects and 15% of the courses were related to sustainability. As of the 2018-2019 academic year, courses within the skill area: sustainable development, have been added to the catalog (Sustainability, n.d).


It is very important for the university to be involved in campaigns centered around sustainability and environmental consciousness. By taking an active role in this field, Freie Universität Berlin is setting an example for other universities in both Germany and Europe as a whole. Part of their mission is to work to a more sustainable future, and to change the way our society views sustainability. Change begins from within, the university has been making strong efforts to become more sustainable as a whole in hopes to inspire other educational institutions to follow. They care about using their energy efficiently and between 2001 and 2011 they reduced their energy consumption by 26%, which resulted in saving 42 million kilowatt hours. It stayed roughly stable after that despite enrollment increasing by roughly 14% in the following years (Sustainability Report, 2018).

The university also cares about gender equality and diversity, as they are important parts of "social sustainability." They have 56% female staff, and roughly 60% female students. They acknowledge that they still could be better though, as only 32% of tenured professors in 2017 were women. The university strives to provide an equal opportunity for everyone (Sustainability Report, 2018).

The project we are pursuing plays a huge role in this sustainable future. Freie Universität Berlin's goal is to develop a strong SDG report and display their environmental consciousness and create attention around metrics to evaluate the sustainability of un3iversities. FU Berlin has made it clear that one of their main goals as an institution is to build a global network in order to spread their ideals and teachings. Through these efforts they'll help establish normalized metrics such as the Impact rankings to gauge a universities research, outreach, and teaching, regarding sustainability.



Conclusions

Writing A Good SDG Report

Based on our analysis we have come up with some recommendations to write an SDG report up to the *Times Higher Education* standards. This data has been collected by looking at reports from universities who put together a full SDG report and submitted enough data to the *Impact Rankings* to make the overall list, since it is the overall report that we are looking to improve, as we don't have any influence over the data that can be submitted for SDGS. Therefore universities such as the Technical University of Munich, who only submit data for one SDG and are really good at it, are not included in our analysis model as they do not have a full report for us to analyze.

Layout and Formatting

- Each SDG should have its own section of the report, 1 to 4 pages long
- The pages can be oriented horizontally or vertically
 - o If oriented horizontally, three or four columns of text per page
 - o If oriented vertically, two columns of text per page
- The number of pages in the report can vary from SDG to SDG
- The report should not have much white space; the pages allotted to each SDG should be filled with text or images about that SDG
- There should be a header bar showing the SDG square and describing the SDG
 - The header can include an image of people from the university working on the SDG or any other related image
 - The header should be anywhere from a quarter of a page to a full page, as long as it is consistent from SDG to SDG
 - The header background should be the color of the SDG square
 - The header should include a description of the SDG
- Since the SDGs are color coded, the colors of the SDG should be worked into the layout so that it is easy to see what SDG you are looking at at all times
- Make use of many in text headers specific to the university's efforts towards progress in that SDG
 - Generally should be seven to ten headers, can be more according to need,
 preferably no more than 15 before it starts to look cluttered
 - Depending on the number of headers used, the text under the headers can range from bullet points to a couple of sentences to a couple of short paragraphs
 - The paragraphs should be brief and understandable by general audiences even if they don't know anything about the university
- When referencing additional things that the university has done that have been written about, use links embedded in text without breaking the flow of the sentence

• It is not necessary to link external publications

Data Presentation

- No graphs
- Highlight two to five key statistics in a sidebar that is unobtrusive
 - Number of key statistics should be roughly consistent per SDG but that is not strictly necessary
- Overall there should not be much data present in the report

Visuals

- See data presentation section for how to visually represent data
- For photographs, make sure the amount of photographs used per section is roughly consistent
 - There need not be photographs if they will take up space that you think ought to be used for describing the actual work the university has done
 - There should be a maximum of three photographs per sdg
 - Photographs should show people, and the impact that the SDG you are talking about has on people
 - Photographs can be of people working on the SDG
- Visuals separate from text other than the data sidebar and any photographs are not necessary
 - Some reports enlarge quotes from important people in the area of the SDG in order to draw attention to them and bring context to their data
- For a color scheme, use the colors of the SDG symbols, adding other colors adds an element of unnecessary confusion
 - One great way to incorporate the color scheme is to have the headings in the color of the SDG
 - Another way that shows up frequently is to have the background of half the page be the color of the sdg

Language Use

- See the data analysis spreadsheet for which keywords are commonly used
- Universities mention themselves a lot
- The tone of the paper should be informative and acreditory
- The paper should have high readability and be comprehensible by a general audience

Key Recommendations

- Freie Universität Berlin should format their report as a goal- oriented report.
- Photographs in reports should be minimal and showcase student and faculty contributions.

- Showcase at least two projects not directly commissioned by the universities in their discussions of each SDG
- Headings represent the beginning of new ideas.
 - Majority of universities feature a minimum of 5-8 distinct headings or initiatives per SDG, regardless of category or topic.
 - We recommend 7-10 distinct headings per SDG
- If present, graphical evidence should highlight only key statistics.
 - o Two Types
 - 3-6 different statistics
 - One major statistic emphasized as a stand alone entity
- It is important to follow the evolution of keywords and concepts.
