


This is the homepage of our "Seven Hills Community Outings" web page. The homepage includes example search strings, a list of definitions for terms used throughout the web page and a link to our tutorial video. Alternatively, there are clickable categories tabs on the left-hand sidebar of the homepage. These tabs are organized by type of outing, and you can click on any of these to view a catalogue of venues in that category.



You can use available search strings to search the web page for specific accommodations or information throughout the resource, using the search bar.




For example, when it is essential that a destination has braille accommodations, you could click in the search bar, type "braille," and hit the enter key. The results that show are all venues that include braille accommodations.



When you click a category, such as "Museums," venues of that type are organized by the region of Massachusetts where they are located, and alphabetized. These category pages include tables that contain the venue's name, address, and a brief, general description of that location.



When you find a venue that interests you, you can click the venue title that links to the venue's informational page. For example, if you are interested in the Durant Kenrick House and Grounds, you could click that venue's name to be taken to its individual page, where we have included the venue's general information and accessibility information. General venue information includes the venue address, cost of visit, reachable phone number, and a link to the venue's website. Accessibility information and additional useful information are included in the table below.



Finally, any venue specific information is included below the table, and there is an open comment section at the bottom of the page where you can leave feedback about a venue, and read any feedback given by others who have visited.
