Students lack skills to speak confidently.

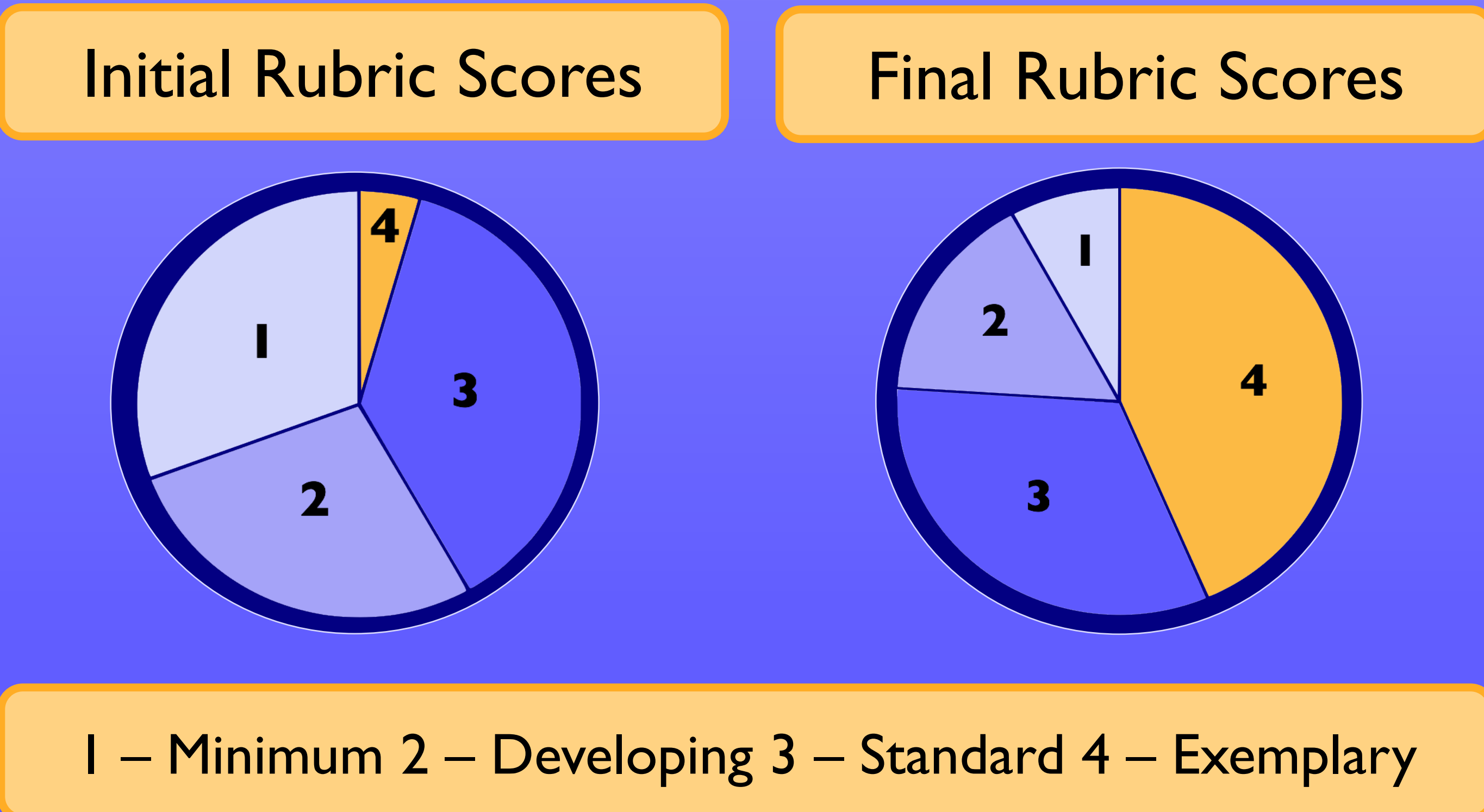
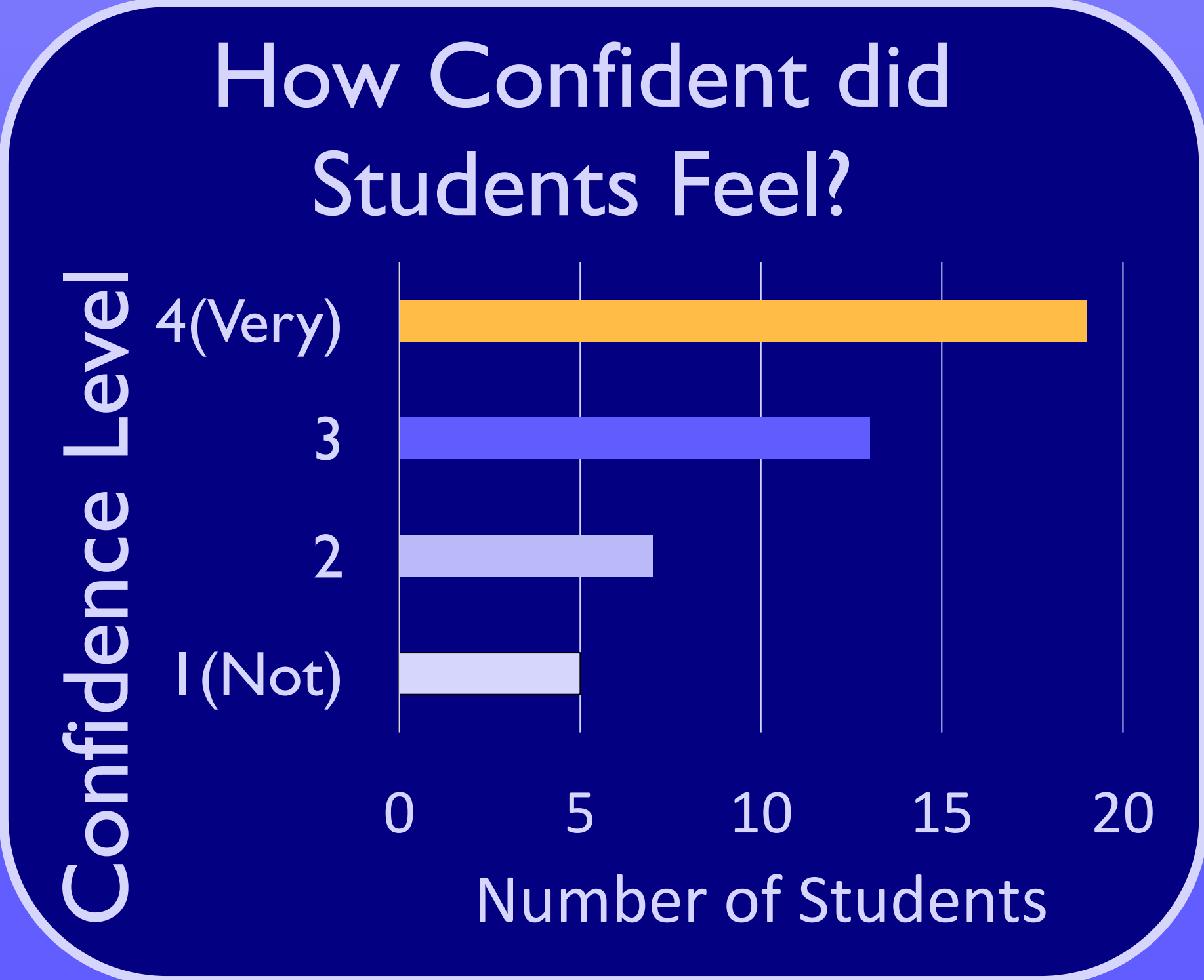
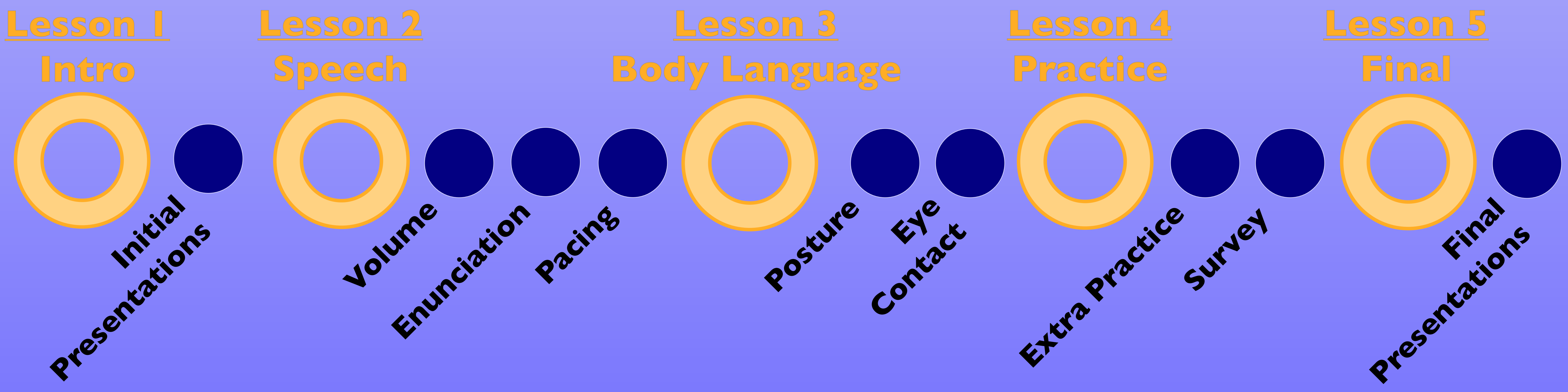
Without these skills, students fall behind in class and lose educational and employment opportunities.

The skills they acquire will help them in the classroom and beyond.

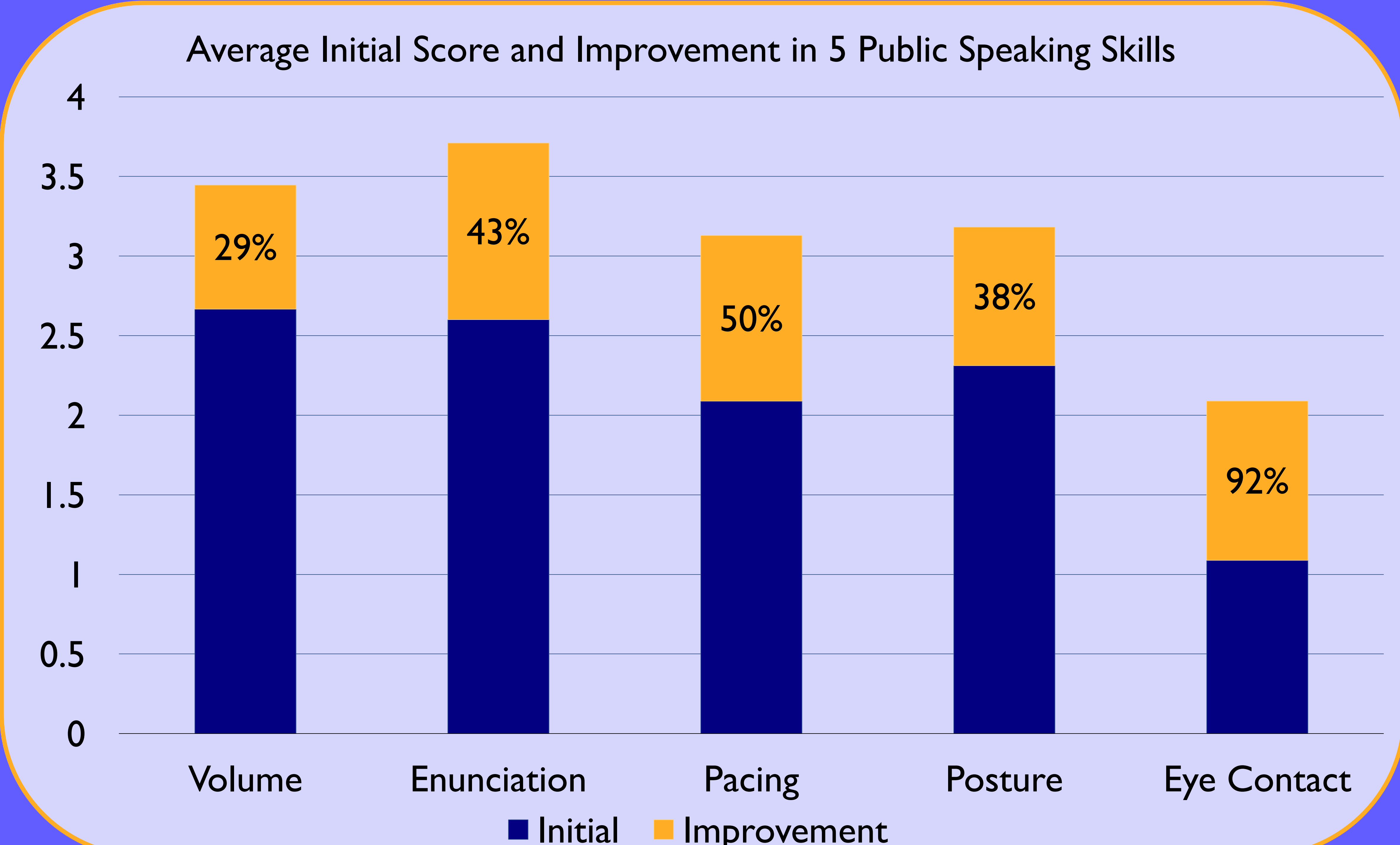
