


Q1 - How would you rank your overall experience with the website?



The color of the design can be somewhat hard to distinguish. The color of the wheel at the bottom to navigate back to home or other sections should maybe be a different color than the green for the icons on the section pages.

The wheel at the bottom isn't very intuitive to know that it is for switching pages. When you hover over the blue blocks that have the names of organizations, and another block comes up under, it feels like you should be able to click the 2nd block or something but it is just a description.

There isn't anything I really disliked about the design.

It feels like it's a lot of button options one one page.

Front page, tracking weapons isn't aligned with the other three categories, there is a goo-like design behind the words which looks a little out of place, and there are links to social networks that don't go anywhere.

The additional website links seem to be in an awkward place for external sources

No breadcrumb trail. Especially when viewing on a cell phone, a breadcrumb trail that follows the page as yiu scroll down will make it much more usable

It was not clear that the button at the bottom of the page would expand and allow me to go to the home page or to a different portion of the website

Very challenging to follow and navigate through the site.

Does not have an intuitive way of going back to previous pages

First page says " Global Weapons Tracking" three times, the menu button on the bottom of the org pages is a little jarring, unclear what the boxes that pop up when I hover a org are, large black title bar is somewhat distracting, logo in top bar isn't aligned with text.

Why do each of the links in the Tracking Weapons section and others have a little arrow and text below it when it is hovered over. This makes the button seem more like a menu for choosing multiple options and is misleading. The menu for the overall website covers the whole screen which is bad. Why are there only cool links for the social media on the main page and not anywhere else. The animated menu in the middle is cool but it doesn't look like a menu option until you click it.

I think the down down descriptions for each link on subpages is slightly confusing. The similar color scheme and shape made it look clickable but it is not. The bottom button for the radial navigation was nice but seemed too large at least on my screen and it lagged when i opened or closed it. One note is some links are either broken or not linked and the team page is empty so those should be fixed or removed


There's a lot of white space

I was a little confused as to the purpose of the site on the home page.


Q17 - How would you rate the speed of this website?

What is one thing you would change to improve this website?

You could probably center the titles of different pages a little more to the right but other than that looks great!

I would change the color of the wheel at the bottom to navigate back to home or other sections to be transparent gray maybe instead of the green transparency that is there.

Changing the icon for the wheel to something that makes it more clear that it is a menu for navigating the site (or even writing menu there or adding tooltips). For the blue blocks, making the one that appears when you hover on the block a lighter version of the current color may make it look more like a description box than something you should be able to click on. Also having that triangle that points down to the description point up instead may make it more clear that the lower is a description of the upper. In that way it looks almost like a speech bubble coming out of the initial blue box which is a more common UI element for that type of hover for description set-up

Probably just a me thing, but on the home page, "Tracking Weapons" isn't quite aligned with the other words. I also think you may want to consider having the links for SOAS and Oxfam from the menu open in new tabs so that the user still has access to your site. The only other thing I noticed is on the organization pages, it might be cool to add more/different photos to some of them (some of them just have a photo of what I'm assuming is the organization logo). Overall, the site is great though!!

Maybe create a drop down menu instead of laying out all the page buttons on one page.

I noticed it says SCRAP right next to the Global Weapons Tracking at the top of every page, but it wasn't easy for me to find out what that actually means. Also, after clicking into About, Meet the Team, etc, there's no easy way to get back to the homepage or the other sections like there is for the rest of the website. Finally, the links to all the external sites open a new tab (which I like) but the website doesn't do this for the SOAS or Oxfam homepages; it just opens up the link in the same tab.
