

Problem

51% of children suffer from malnutrition in Sierra Leone¹





WHY

Livestock populations decreased do to war.

Rice is staple food but lacks many nutrients.

Unsustainable agriculture.

Climate variability.

Objectives

- Enhance nutritional verity and quantity in diets.
- Create self-sustainable communities.
- Promote and support Heifer Internationals work.

Project Goal

To raise \$1,200 to donate to Heifer International. This will allow Heifer to send 5 goats and 5 sheep to a Sierra Leone project center.



To Reach Goal


- 1) Create a Team Heifer Website. http://teamheifer.heifer.org/SierraLeone
