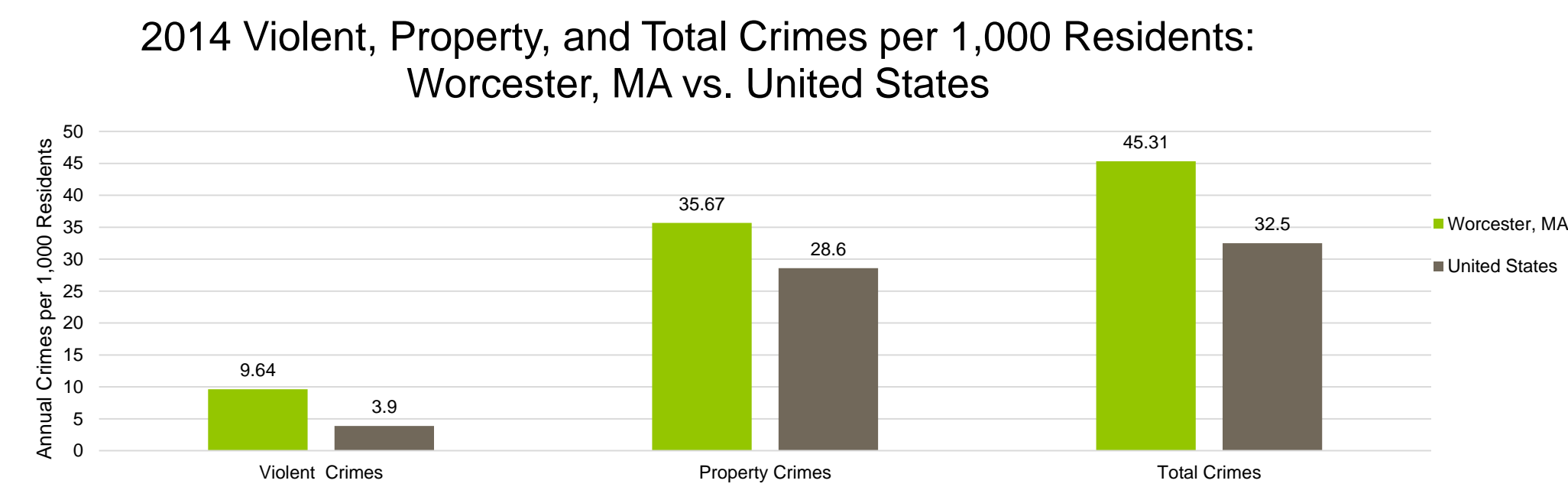


## The Problem

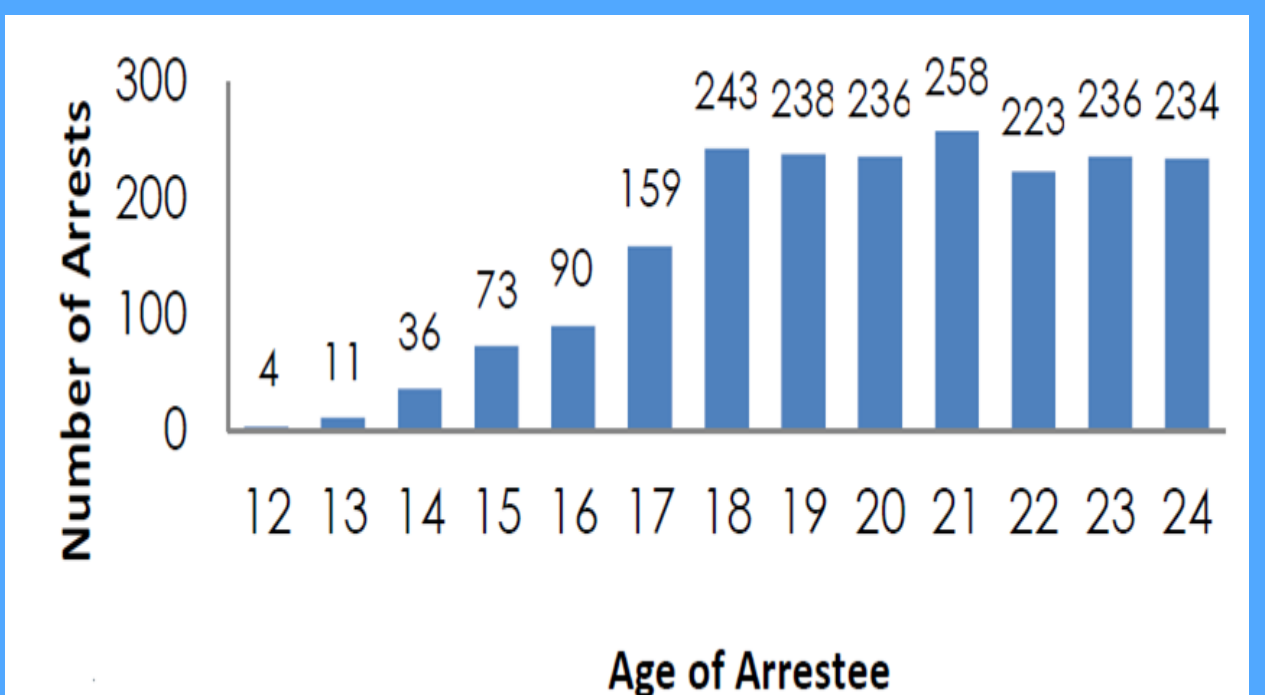

## Our Objective

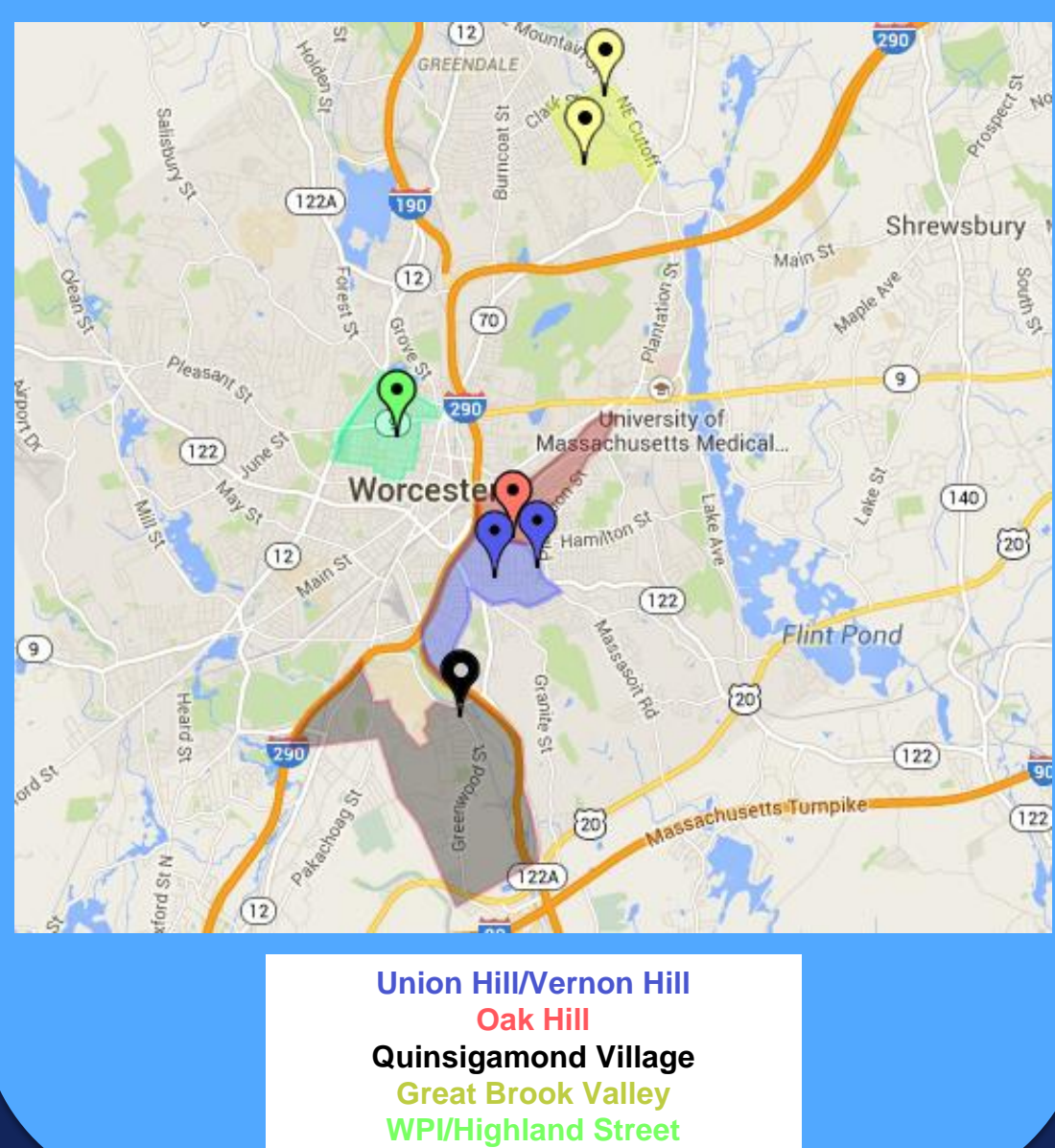
To keep kids in Worcester off the streets after school, and direct them towards the multiple programs offered.

### Location of Schools in Targeted Neighborhoods

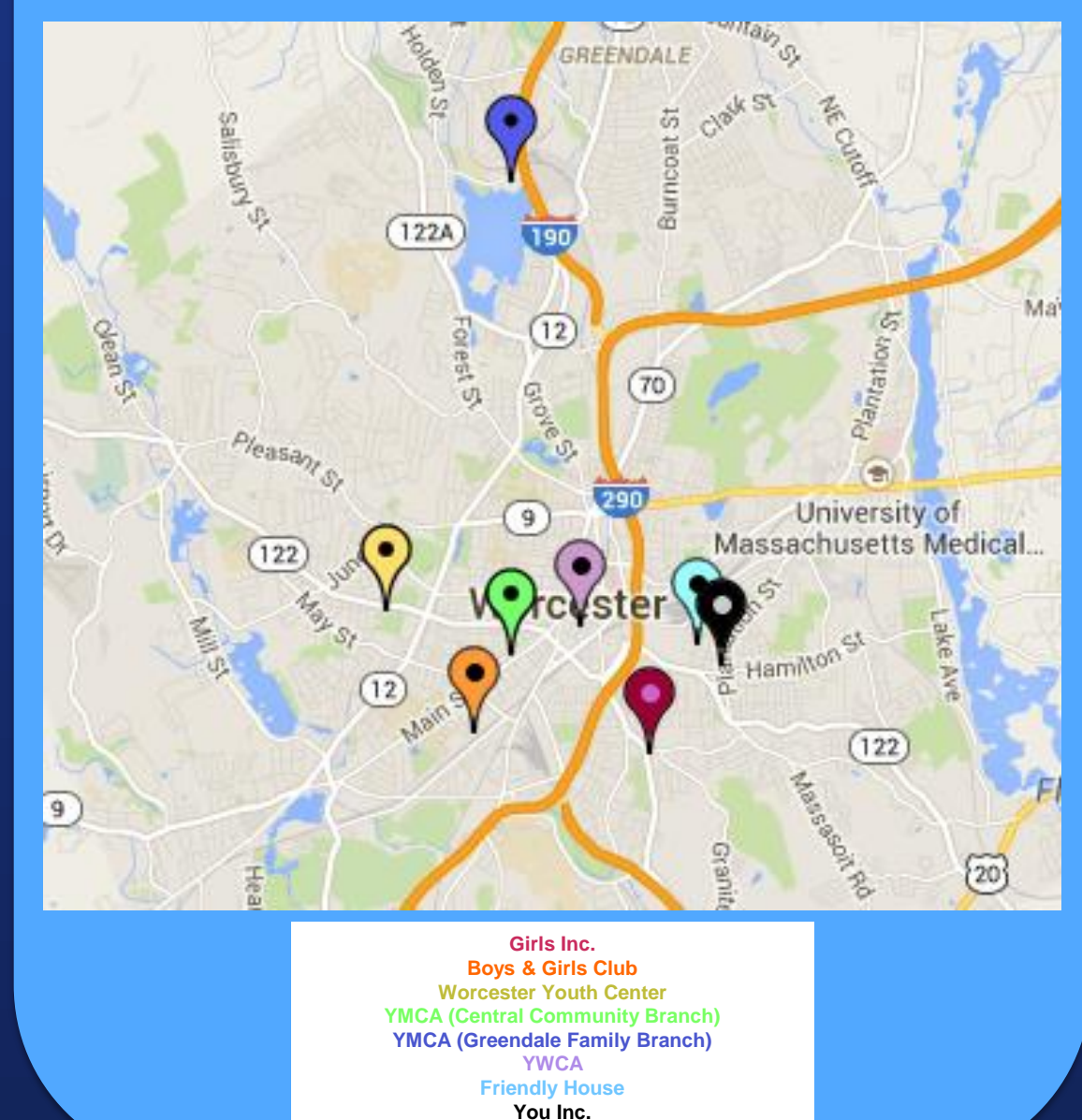
