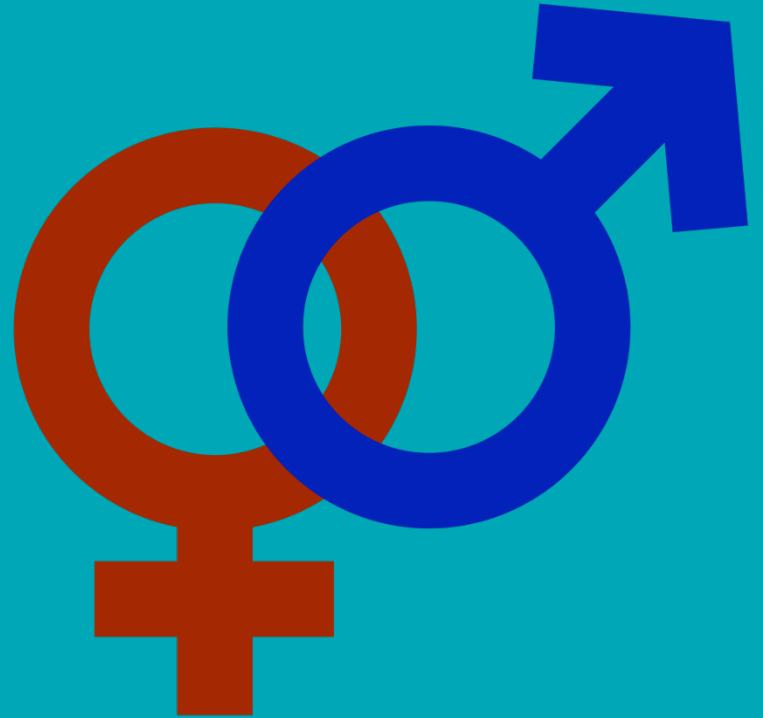

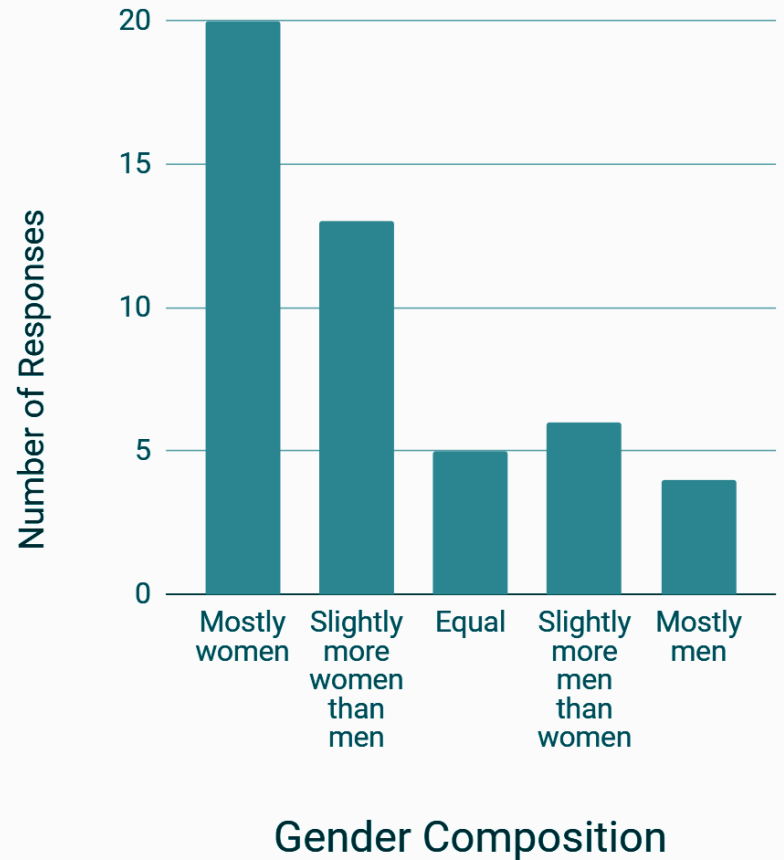

Overall Gender Composition of ITP Alumni's Institutions

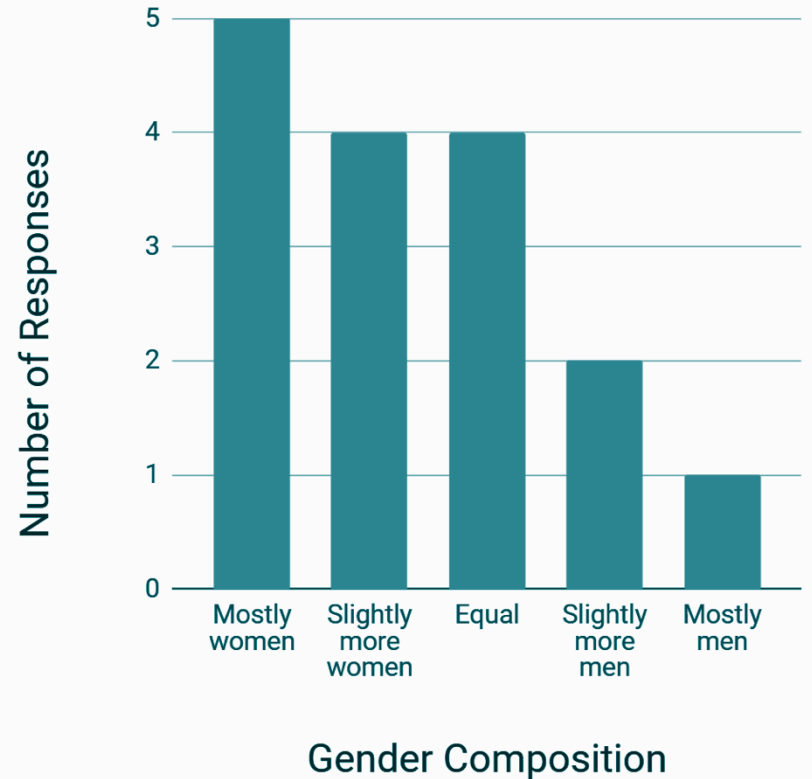

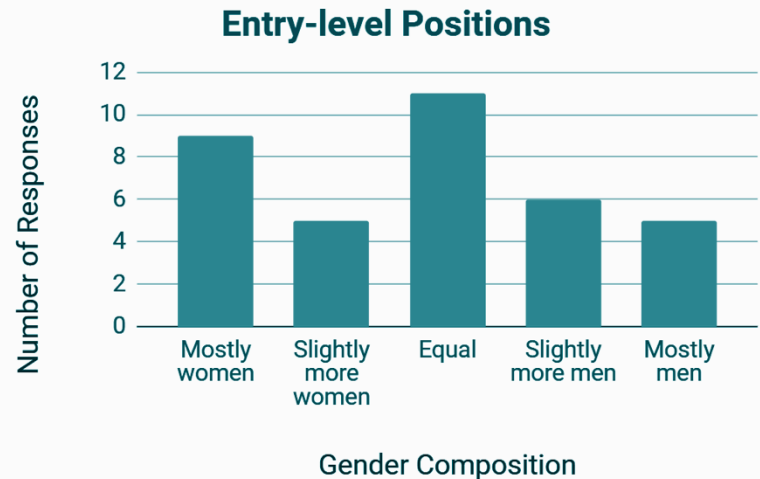

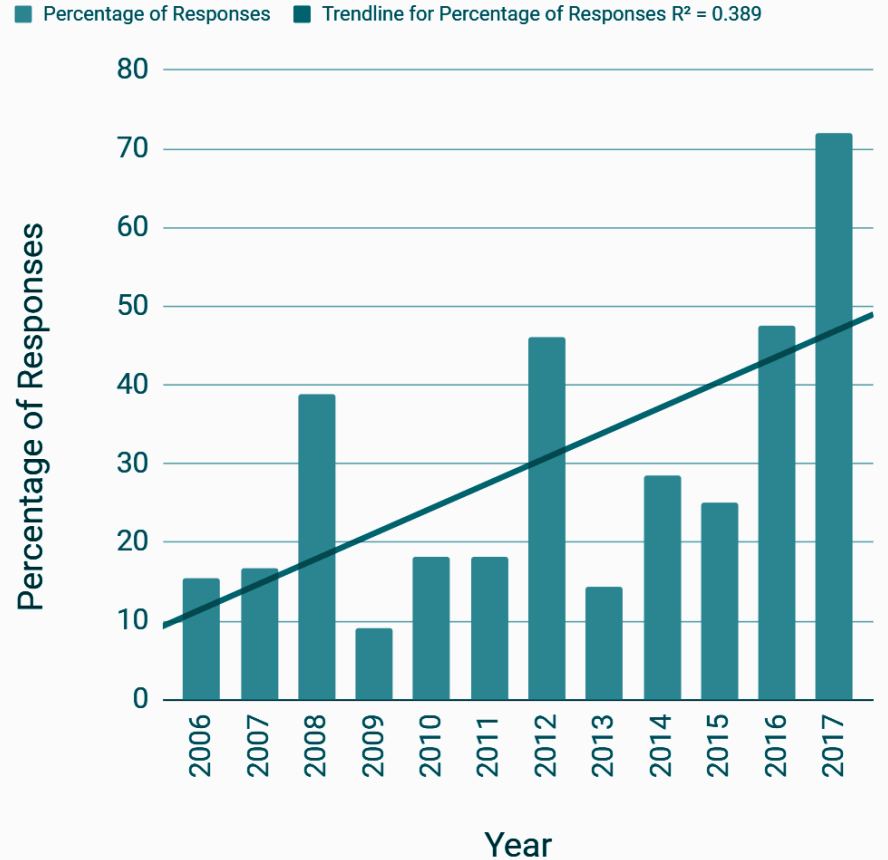

Response Rates By Year to SurveyMonkey

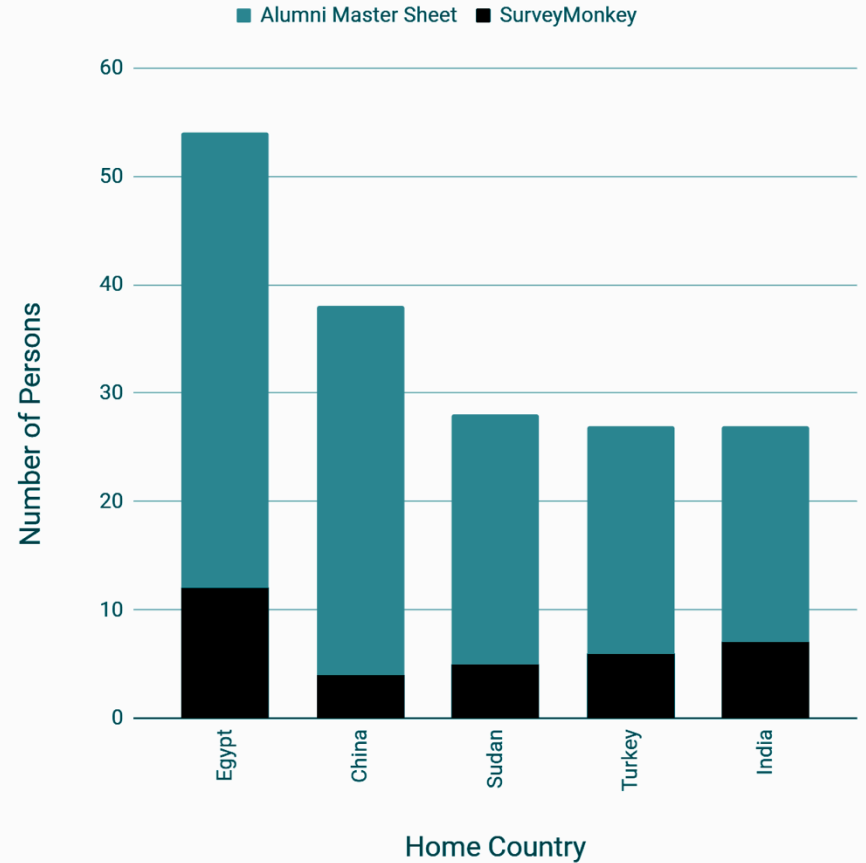

Top 5 Countries Represented by ITP Alumni

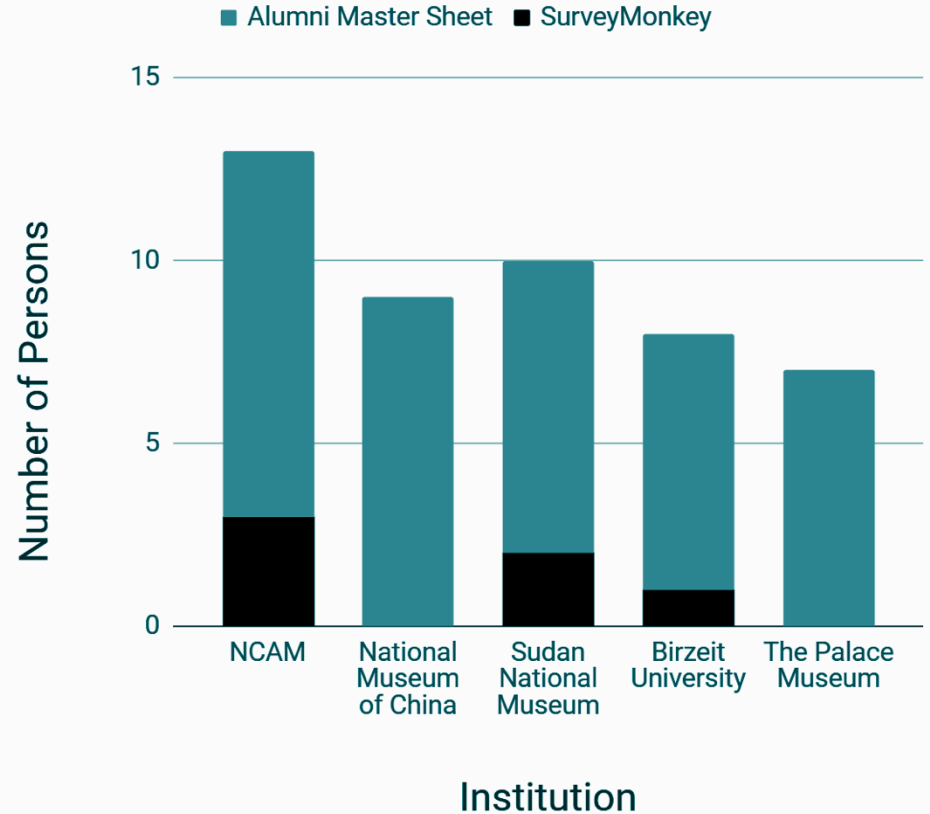
