

ONS MISSIE OUR MISSION

Hierdie projek het ten doel om die perspektiewe rondom die Stellenbosch Munisipaliteit se pogings om die Suid-Afrikaanse behuisingskrisis aan te spreek, te dokumenteer deur 'n gevallestudie van die Mountain View-gemeenskap (Jamestown) te skep. Ons was veral geïnteresseerd in die ondersoek van hoe mense die IRDP-benadering beskou om beter en bekostigbare behuising te bied, asook die aanvaarbaarheid om lae-inkomste behuisingsontwikkelings met middelinkomste en hoëinkomste-inwoners te integreer.

This project aimed to document the perspectives surrounding the Stellenbosch Municipality's efforts in addressing the South African housing crisis by creating a case study of the Mountain View (Jamestown) community. We were particularly interested in exploring how people perceive the IRDP approach to providing improved and affordable housing as well as the acceptability of integrating low-income housing developments with middle-income and high-income residents.

WAT ONS UIT U GEMEENSAP GELEER HET WHAT WE LEARNED FROM YOUR COMMUNITY

71% van die RDP-begunstigdes het gesê dat hulle 'n veilige eienaarskap van hul huis het, het dit laat voel soos die huis. Ten spyte van die terugslag van beperkte befondsing en hulpbronne, streef die Munisipaliteit Stellenbosch voortdurend om basiese dienste en verbeterde geriewe aan al sy bestanddele te lewer, deur na-ure te werk en onophoudelik beskikbaar te stel.

71% of RDP beneficiaries said having secure ownership of their house made it feel like home. Despite the setback of limited funding and resources, the Stellenbosch Municipality continually strives to deliver basic services and enhanced-amenities to all of its constituents, through working after hours and making themselves available incessantly.



57% van die deelnemers het 'n besorgdheid gehad oor die veiligheid van die gemeenskap. Ons glo met die toevoeging van straatligte, speedbumps en gemeenskapsdeelname sal die gemeenskap veiliger voel.

57% of participants had a concern about the safety of the community. We believe with the additions of streetlights, speedbumps, and community participation the community would feel safer.



Ons raai jou deelname sowel as gemeenskapsdeelname aan om jou verantwoordelikhede as huiseienaar te verstaan en bewus te wees van wat in jou gemeenskap gebeur. Ons stel voor om betrokke te raak deur opsies soos bywoning van vergaderings en kontak met die munisipaliteit of wyksraadslid met enige vrae of kommentaar. Miskien begin 'n gemeenskapsprojek of komitee, vra amptenare moontlike maniere om betrokke te raak.

We recommend your participation as well as community participation in order to understand your responsibilities as a homeowner and be aware of what is happening in your community. We suggest becoming involved through options such as attending meetings and contacting the municipality or ward councillor with any questions or concerns. Perhaps start a community project or committee, ask officials potential ways to get involved.
