Their names were Tootsie, Curry, and Mocha.




The piggies would like to teach you how to draw a simple guinea pig!

Many children with and without dyslexia enjoy art as a way to express themselves.







3. Draw a circle near the ear for the eye and draw a dash below the eye for a nose


4. Draw a smile under the nose

They even went to school together.




The piggies have to get to school on time!

Piggies with dyslexia often flip the following letters: d b p q.


This means: b = d, d = b,

p = q


q = p.

If those letters appear in the puzzle and puzzle clues, they will be flipped but the meaning of the letter will stay the same!


The pig friends want you to have fun and take your time!



The words also looked like they were jumbled.


This confused and upset Tootsie.

The following week, Tootsie was diagnosed with dyslexia.




Oh no the piggies have lost their words! They need your help to find the missing words for them, but they also want you to have fun while finding them!




Dyslexia is a reading and learning problem some piggies have.


Tootsie had never heard of dyslexia.

Connect the numbers to make the hidden picture.






She was embarrassed to tell her friends.


Mocha and Curry knew something was wrong, but Tootsie kept her dyslexia a secret.



Piggies with dyslexia often feel mentally lost, almost like they are lost in a maze.


Help the piggies find their way by leading them through the guinea pig maze.

Example: Ox is the letter O.




All these letters together will form a sentence! The end of each of the words is not marked, so you will have to decide where words end and begin.









She met new animals at these classes.

Each letter of the alphabet is represented by a number. There is a key, hidden in a hay pile, showing you the letter each number represents.




Decode each of the numbers to form words.

They learned that anyone can have dyslexia.




Tootsie has an important message for you about guinea pigs. And the words in the message are spelled backwards.

Dyslexic.




Often piggies with dyslexia find it helpful to look for patterns in the sentences they are reading.

The following puzzle has to do with number patterns and shape patterns.




